


Photo above: Datong Yungang Grottoes, Shanxi Province

#### **TOUR OVERVIEW**

This 3-day itinerary offers a deep dive into the rich historical and cultural tapestry of Datong, a city that was once the capital of the Northern Wei Dynasty. From breathtaking UNESCO World Heritage sites to astonishing ancient architecture and vibrant city life, this tour is a perfect blend of art, history, and engineering marvels.

#### **DAY-TO-DAY PROGRAM**

#### Important Note on Itinerary Flexibility

This proposed itinerary is structured based on current flight availability and is subject to adjustment upon final confirmation of your travel arrangements. To ensure the best possible experience, our local guide may optimize the order of visits based on real-time conditions, such as crowd levels and reservation availability at the sites.

## Day 1 April 21 Tuesday Fly to Datong 2 nights in Datong (no meals are included)

- 16:55 Flight HO1055 Shanghai Hongqiao airport departure
  - \*Reference only, subject to final confirmation.
- 20:00 Datong Yungang airport arrival \**Reference only, subject to final confirmation.*

Airport pickup and drive to hotel in Datong.

Check-in at Datong Garden Hotel for 2 nights. Dinner is not included

Datong Garden Hotel is located in the heart of the Ancient City, so you might like to take a leisurely stroll through the Old Town to look for some local snacks.

# Day 2 April 22 Wednesday City Wall, Datong Museum, and Hanging Temple (Hotel breakfast and lunch are included)

Hotel breakfast

- O8:15 Your exploration begins with a walk to the magnificent **Datong City Wall** (10-15 min.). This recently restored Ming Dynasty structure is one of the best-preserved ancient city walls in China. Take a walk along the broad ramparts for a panoramic view of the old city and its striking contrast with the new.
- O9:00 Head to the **Datong Museum** (30 min. by vehicle). Its modern architecture houses a vast collection of relics that tell the story of Datong's past as the capital of the Northern Wei Dynasty and a crucial junction on the Silk Road. This visit provides essential context for the historical sites you will see over the next two days.
- We will drive 1.5 hours to **Mount Heng**, one of China's Five Great Sacred Mountains.

Lunch: Enjoy a local meal near the Hanging Temple.

- 14:30 Visit the magnificent **Hanging Temple** (Xuankong Si). Prepare to be amazed by this engineering feat, a temple that hangs on a cliff and uniquely combines Buddhism, Taoism, and Confucianism. Walking its narrow walkways is a truly unique experience.
- 16:30 Drive back to hotel in Datong.
- 18:00/18:30 Hotel arrival, the rest of the day is free for you to relax or explore on your own.
- Day 3 April 23 Thursday
  Yungang Grottoes, Nine-Dragon Screen, Huayan
  Temple, and Shanhua Temple
  Fly back to Shanghai
  (Hotel breakfast and lunch are included)

Hotel breakfast

08:15 Hotel departure, drive to the Yungang Grottoes, approx. 45 min. -1 hour

#### **The Unforgettable Yungang Grottoes**

O9:00 Dedicate your morning to the Yungang Grottoes (UNESCO World Heritage Site). This is the absolute highlight of the tour. Marvel at over 51,000 statues carved into the sandstone cliffs, representing the pinnacle of Chinese Buddhist art from the 5th and 6th centuries. The colossal Buddhas, intricate carvings, and vibrant colors in Cave 6, Cave 16-20 (the five iconic caves of Tan Yao), and the 13.7-meter-tall seated Buddha in Cave 20 are simply aweinspiring.

12:00 Continue to visit Datong's Nine-Dragon Screen (Jiulong Bi), one of the most famous dragon walls in China. Built during the Ming Dynasty (14th century), this magnificent glazed-tile wall stretches about 45 meters (148 feet) long and stands 8 meters (26 feet) high. It is decorated with nine large, vividly colored dragons, each portrayed soaring among clouds and waves. The wall was originally constructed to protect the mansion of a Ming prince from evil spirits, and today it is admired as a masterpiece of ancient Chinese decorative art and symbolism.

This is a quick photo stop.

#### 13:00 Enjoy a local **Shanxi-style lunch**:

At noon, savor a delicious Shanxi-style lunch, featuring the region's famous hand-pulled noodles, vinegar-based dishes, and a variety of hearty local specialties that showcase the rich flavors and culinary traditions of northern China.

#### 14:00 Serenity at Huayan Temple

Visit Huayan Temple, a massive temple complex reflecting the Liao and Jin Dynasties' architectural style. It is unique for being split into two sections:

Upper Monastery: Home to the magnificent Daxiong Baodian (Great Hall), one of the largest Buddhist halls in China.

Lower Monastery: Features the Bojia Jiaocang Tibetan Scripture Hall, built underground and housing a revolving sutra cabinet—a true architectural gem.

Continue to **Shanhua Temple**, an ancient complex dating back to the Tang Dynasty. Renowned for its tranquil atmosphere and harmonious layout, the temple features beautifully preserved halls. Key highlights include the majestic Three Buddhas and the Sutra Pavilion, creating a perfect setting for quiet contemplation.

#### 17:00 Free Time for Refreshments & Souvenirs

A dedicated period to enjoy a coffee, sample a local snack, or pick up some final mementos. This also serves as a comfortable buffer for the day's schedule.
