UNESCO MOUNT WUYI 2 DAYS

TRIP OVERVIEW

Just a comfortable high-speed train ride from Shanghai, Wuyishan (Mount Wuyi) is the perfect weekend escape. A UNESCO World Nature & Culture Heritage site, this region is known for its dramatic Danxia cliffs, tea-covered valleys, and the winding Nine Bend River. Over two days, we'll relax by hiking through lush tea plantations, exploring peaceful forest trails, and drifting down the river on a traditional bamboo raft. It's an easy, refreshing getaway that blends nature, culture, and slow-paced adventure in one of Fujian's most beautiful mountain areas.

DAY-TO-DAY PROGRAM

Day 1 March 14 Saturday
**Shanghai speed train to Wuyishan (Mount Wuyi),
1 night in Wuyishan (dinner is included)**

Meet and greet at the railway station, then transfer to the hotel (30 min.) for check-in at **Haloyon Villa Wuyi**, our boutique resort nestled in the scenic Wuyi Mountains.

** We recommend packing portable snacks or meals, as no formal lunch stop is scheduled in today's itinerary.*

12:50 Wuyishan Nine-Bend Stream Bamboo Rafting

After check in, we will depart from the hotel by our own vehicle. Upon arrival at the entrance of Wuyishan National Park, we will switch to the scenic area shuttle bus, which will take us to the starting point (upper station) of the bamboo rafting.

13:30 The rafting itself is a serene 90-minute journey along the 9.5-kilometer Nine-Bend Stream, gliding past majestic Danxia landscapes, unique rock formations, and ancient cliff carvings.

During the serene bamboo rafting, we can leisurely enjoy the packed lunch you've prepared in advance, turning the journey into a unique floating picnic.

15:00 **Dawang Peak (Great King Peak):
Hike at Dawang Peak (Great King Peak)**

Following the bamboo rafting, we will hike up Dawang Peak, one of the most iconic landmarks of Wuyishan (Mount Wuyi), standing at approximately 530 meters. Please wear a pair of comfortable shoes.

**If you wish to relax further, you may skip the hike. Our vehicle will be available to take you back to the hotel directly after the bamboo rafting.*

The ascent to the summit takes about 1 hour. The trail consists primarily of stone steps with beautiful scenic viewpoints along the way. Please note that the path includes a few steep steps and a narrow rock crevice; those with a fear of heights should consider this.

The rewarding summit offers a panoramic view of the Nine-Bend Stream and the surrounding mountain ranges, perfect for photography.

Evening (Optional): Impression Da Hong Pao Show

You may opt to watch the famous outdoor show "Impression Da Hong Pao" (starts at 19:30, lasts 70 min). Directed by Zhang Yimou, it showcases Wuyishan's tea culture and history through stunning visual effects and storytelling.

As the restaurant/show venue is within walking distance from the hotel, you can conveniently walk back by yourselves after the event (15-20 min.)

UNESCO MOUNT WUYI 2 DAYS

07:45 **Morning Hike: The Tea Plantation Trail (Da Wuyi Trail Segment)**

A scenic hike through ancient tea gardens.

Overview

This trek immerses you in the heart of Wuyishan's tea culture, winding through ancient plantations and past iconic rock formations. With the base elevation around 140 meters and the highest point under 400 meters, the trail features some "ups and downs" but is overall considered gentle and manageable.

approx. 5-6 km

- Start: We drive from the hotel to Lantang Village, where the hike begins.
- Hike: Trek through Matouyan (Horse Head Rock) to the legendary Da Hong Pao Mother Trees. Plan for about 30-45 minutes to visit the site.
- Return: After the visit, take the scenic shuttle bus from Da Hong Pao to the park gate, where our vehicle will return us to the hotel.

12:00 Hotel check out

Afternoon: Cultural Exploration

Following lunch, we will visit two key sites to delve deeper into Wuyishan's tea heritage. The order of visits may be adjusted on the day for optimal flow.

- A Local Tea Workshop: See firsthand how the famous Wuyi rock tea is produced and processed.
- Xiamei Village: Explore this historic tea-trading village, which served as a key starting point of the Ancient Tea Road during the Qing Dynasty. Stroll through its well-preserved Ming and Qing architecture, stone-paved lanes, and canals for a vivid glimpse into the region's rich past.
